

April, 2013 The largest ever exhibition to be held in Libya will transform the parking area of Tripoli Sports City, an area of over 30,000 square meters into the largest ever exhibition centre in Libya sending a clear and unequivocal message that the country is ready to do business.

- HEPO GREECE, the Hellenic Export Promotion Organization, confirmed to participate with 13 companies at LIBYA BUILD 2013.
- Al Nesma the official distributor of DAIKIN in Libya signed contract with ATEX to be the official badge sponsor of Libya Build 2013.
- Participation of official countries at Libya Build 2013 are from Austria, Belgium, China, Czech Republic ,Egypt, France, Greece, Italy, Malaysia, Malta, South Korea, Spain, Tunis and Turkey.
- ADVANTAGE AUSTRIA the foreign trade promotion organization of the Austrian Federal Economic Chamber (WKÖ), will participate with 15 Austrian companies.
